**LOR 111556 – East 36<sup>th</sup> Street (Globe Ave. to Grove Ave.)**

[LORAIN, OHIO] – The City of Lorain proposes to improve East 36<sup>th</sup> Street in the City of Lorain, Lorain County, Ohio. The work includes grinding of existing asphalt roadway, base repairs as required, and placement of 3 inches of new asphalt, temporary roadway markings, and permanent roadway markings. This project will run from Globe Avenue to Grove Avenue. Construction is currently scheduled to begin summer 2022 and will last approximately 3 months.

Due to the proximity to private property, the City is seeking public input about the project in general. Questions and/or comments regarding this project may be directed to Veronica A.
